For use only in broiler chicken feeds for the prevention and control of coccidiosis caused by *Eimeria acervulina*, *E. brunetti*, *E. maxima*, *E. mivati*, *E. necatrix* and *E. tenella*.

Directions for use

Read label before use.

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice if necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

Thoroughly mix Yumamycin 1% microGranulate into the feed at a rate of 500g/ tonne of feed, to obtain a concentration of 5g/T maduramicin ammonium in the finished feed.

Feeds containing Yumamycin should be the only ration fed to broilers to avoid dilution of the active ingredient.

Withholding Periods:

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds.

Meat: Nil

Eggs: Eggs from treated birds must not be sold for human consumption for 10 days following the last treatment

Contraindications

Do not treat animals with feed supplemented with Yumamycin 1% microGranulate while receiving, or for at least SEVEN days before or after receiving feed containing tiamulin.

Do not administer to horses or other equines.

Warning: Causes serious eye irritation.

Precautions: Wash hands thoroughly after handling.

Wear protective gloves, eye and face protection.

First Aid: IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.

Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do.

Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists seek medical attention or advice.

Disposal: Preferably dispose of product by use. Shake bag empty into medicated feed.

Dispose of unused product and empty packaging at an approved landfill or other facility.



Storage: Store in a dry place below 25°C.

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
