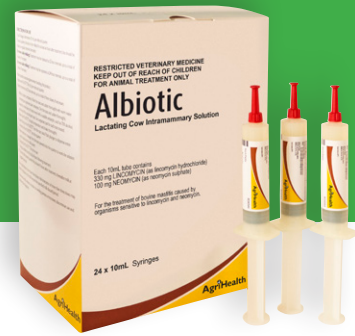

Albiotic



WHAT IS ALBIOTIC?

Albiotic are broad spectrum lactating cow intramammary syringes. Each 10mL syringe contains the antibiotics lincomycin (330mg) and neomycin (100mg).

Albiotic was previously called Lincocin Forte.

WHAT IS ALBIOTIC FOR?

Albiotic is a broad spectrum treatment of mastitis in cows. It has proven, high bacteriological cure rates vs typical mastitis pathogens.

WHEN SHOULD YOU USE ALBIOTIC?

Albiotic is suitable for mastitis cases caused by *Staphylococcus aureus*, CNS, and *Streptococcal spp.* (*Streptococcus agalactiae*, *Streptococcus dysgalactiae* and *Streptococcus uberis*). Albiotic is also effective against *E. coli* and other Gram negative bacteria.

HOW DO YOU USE ALBIOTIC?

Administer contents of one 10mL syringe into each infected quarter, via the teat canal, immediately after milking.

Treated quarters should not be milked for at least six hours after treatment, but should be milked at regular intervals thereafter.

For twice daily milking: Treatment of one syringe at 12 hour intervals, for three treatments.

For once daily milking: Treatment of one syringe at 24 hour intervals, for three treatments.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD

Milk: Twice daily milking: 5 milkings (approx 60 hours)

For once daily milking: 4 milkings (approx 96 hours)

Meat: 10 days

STORAGE

Store below 30°C.

PACK SIZES

Available in packs of 24 x 10mL syringes.
