TyloVet 200 Injection



WHAT IS TYLOVET?

Broad spectrum solution for intramuscular injection, containing tylosin 200mg/mL, as tylosin base.

WHAT IS TYLOVET FOR?

TyloVet is an antibiotic injection that is effective against bacteria associated with mastitis (eg. *Staphylococci* and *Streptococci*).

TyloVet is able to cross from the blood stream into milk, where tylosin becomes trapped. This increases TyloVet's effectiveness for mastitis treatment.

WHEN SHOULD YOU USE TYLOVET?

TyloVet is suited for the treatment of mastitis, particularly when more than one quarter is infected.

NZ trial work (McDougall, 1998) showed that 85% of cows with mastitis had more than one quarter infected.

TyloVet may also be used to treat metritis, respiratory infections, footrot and calf diphtheria.

HOW DO YOU USE TYLOVET?

Administer by intramuscular injection in cattle.

Give intramuscular injections into the anterior half of the neck.

Alternate the injection site when giving repeated daily doses. Administer doses over 15mL at different sites.

Dose for cattle: 2.5 - 5mL/100kg liveweight daily, for up to 5 days.

eg 500kg cow daily dose is typically 25mL for treating mastitis, for at least 3 days.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD

Milk: 72 hours

Meat: 21 days

STORAGE

Store below 25°C, protected from light.

Discard unused content 28 days after opening.

PACK SIZES

Available in 100mL and 250mL multi-dose bottles.
